Rosetta and her children, ages 18, 15, 11 and 5 years, were forced to move from their apartment due to a rent increase and fear after someone broke in while they were home. Their living situation went from bad to worse as they tried to find a safe, affordable place to live. They moved into one bedroom of a two-bedroom apartment. Being a temporary arrangement, Rosetta and family were forced to move again, this time into her mother's cold cramped concrete basement.

Rosetta, who had previously applied for a Habitat Home, finally qualified to be a Habitat for Humanity partner. Rosetta's fear of being turned down again was replaced with joy when she received the welcoming call. Her children were elated to be chosen. One child said, "Mom, stop playing with me!" The children cannot wait to move to their new home in O'Fallon, where they will attend public school, build relationships with other kids, enjoy sports and explore other activities.

Habitat is a Hand Up, not a Hand Out. Rosetta will invest 200+ hours of sweat equity in building her home by working at her build site, the Habitat Restore and attending finance classes, while also working a full-time job and raising four children.
